Hi Dr Shapiro,

I am a PhD student in Dr John Richey's lab at Virginia Tech. My primary interests are perceived control, effort-related processes, and associated clinical outcomes. I have completed one control-related project in a non-clinical sample (link below) and am currently writing up an fMRI project using the same design. Through Dr Warren Bickel's International Quit and Recovery website (<https://quitandrecovery.org/>), I have another project that uses a relatively novel drug-specific LoC measure in a sample of recovered and currently using drug addicts (n = 377). TERRIFIC WORK! EXCELLENT!

I have only recently discovered your work and I am very excited to incorporate your ideas into some new clinical projects! In the short term, I am planning to use the Shapiro Control Inventory to characterize control profiles in some (new, I think) clinical populations: recovered drug addicts and adults with social anxiety. GREAT IDEA, THIS WOULD BE VERY HELPFUL! I also plan to incorporate the SCI into my dissertation projects, which will look at how SCI profiles relate to anhedonic symptomology and related biomarkers. AGAIN , WOULD BE FASCINATING! In the longer term, I am interested in piloting a simple incarnation of Control Therapy (or elements of Control Therapy tailored for anhedonia specifically) via a mobile phone-based app. GREAT! AS YOU GET CLOSER, PLEASE CONSIDER APPLYING FOR A CONTROL THERAPY GRANT (PER THE WEBSITE!)

Something always seemed missing from the story of perceived control in the literature, "more internal control = better". I think your SCI/

Control Therapy approach offers some much-needed dimensionality to the study of control--THANKS!!! I look forward to delving in! Thank you for sharing all of your materials via the website! A PLEASURE....GOOD LUCK IN YOUR WORK (AND IN KEEPING A POSITIVE SENSE OF CONTROL --IN MANY MODES!:)
